The author traces this journey, explaining the company's leadership in automotive engineering, its styling successes and failures, its changing management, and its activities from auto racing to defense production to real estate. Throughout, the colorful personalities of its leaders—including Chrysler himself and Lee Iacocca—emerge as strong forces in the company's development, imparting a risk-taking mentality that gave the company its verve.
