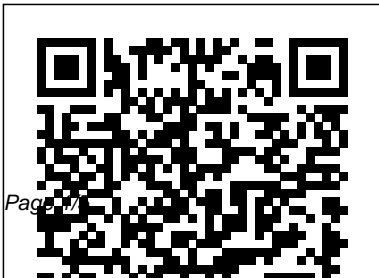

By the early 1960s, the Ford Motor Company, built to bring automobile transportation to the masses, was falling behind.
