Your 1999 Chevrolet Suburban may have a low idle condition due to a dirty throttle body. The warm idle speed should be 700-800 rpm. If you are seeing an idle speed any lower 600 rpm then cleaning or having the throttle body cleaned should help bring the idle speed back up to normal.

At the end of the turn over cycle, it sputters like it wants to start, but won't. First we've changed the the ignition module, which got the car started for about a week.

Lifter tick is a common occurrence in V-8 engines like the Chevy 5.3-liter Vortec. This ticking sound is caused by the valve lifters, which are filled with oil during engine operation. When your engine sits, the oil can seep out of the lifters. When this happens, the lifter will tick at start-up until it refills with engine oil.
