Substances can be divided into three types – Acid, Base and Salt. ACID: Taste of acid is sour. There are many substances that contain acid and so taste sour. For example – lemon, curd, pickles, orange juice, vinegar, etc. Substances that taste sour are called acidic. The chemical nature of such substance is known as ACIDIC.

Also, note that all metals do not react with bases. The metal must be more reactive than the metals present in the base for the reaction to take place. Base + Metal → Salt + Hydrogen gas ... Base + Acid → Salt + H₂O (v) Base + Non Metallic oxide → Salt + H₂O.

Notice also, the mention of a strong acid is usually omitted and the phrase "salt of a weak base" is used. Of course, the strong acid had to be present to make the salt, but its presence is assumed. 4) A salt of a weak acid and a weak base produces a solution whose pH depends on the strengths of the acid and base which made the salt.

Acids and bases make a very important part of chemistry. An acid is a compound which gives H⁺ ions when dissolved in water whereas a base is a compound which gives OH⁻ ions in water. When there is a reaction between the acid and base compounds, the end product is always neutral as the acid and base neutralize each others effect.

Salts: Salts are the ionic compounds which are produced after the neutralization reaction between acid and base. Salts are electrically neutral. There are number of salts but sodium chloride is the most common among them. Sodium chloride is also known as table salt or common salt. Sodium chloride is used to enhance the taste of food.
