In Acrobat/Reader 9 and earlier, JavaScript toolbar buttons are placed on the "Add-Ons" toolbar (Figure 7). If this toolbar is not visible then Right Click on an empty part of the Acrobat toolbar area and select "Add-Ons." In Acrobat/Reader X and XI the JavaScript toolbar buttons are placed in the "Add-on Tools" Pane in the Tools Panel (Figure 8).
