The last 37 problems are word problems; twelve which ask students to find a number under a given set of conditions. Some problems are percentage problems and distance problems. There is a pair of word problems where students are asked to convert temperature given in degrees Celsius to degrees Fahrenheit, and vice versa. There are other word problems where students have to determine how to use the information in the problem to substitute for one or multiple variables to reduce the equation to a single variable linear equation.
