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Prolonged Service, Outpatient Face-to-Face Time 99354 first 30 – 74 min. 99355 each add. 15 – 30 min. (beyond 1st hr.) Face-to-Face: Outpatient prolonged service time must be face-to-face. Floor/unit time in the ER or other outpatient settings does not count.

N. Ambulatory surgery. For ambulatory surgery, code the diagnosis for which the surgery was performed. If the postoperative diagnosis is known to be different from the preoperative diagnosis at the time the diagnosis is confirmed, select the postoperative diagnosis for coding, since it is the most definitive.

Definition of ASC To understand correct coding and billing for an ASC, you must first understand what an ASC is. The Medicare Carriers Manual, section 10.1, defines an ASC as a distinct entity, operating exclusively to furnish

outpatient surgical services. ASCs are not in the business of providing office visits, laboratory services, diagnostic tests, etc.
Diagnostic Coding and Reporting Guidelines for Outpatient ...
Similar to OPPTS, the Outpatient Code Editor is also not utilized in the professional fee guidelines. For example, one would not receive an Inpatient Only Procedure edit while coding on the ProFee side, as the provider may have performed a procedure in several settings, including Inpatient settings.

ICD-10 OFFICIAL GUIDELINES FOR CODING AND REPORTING. SECTION

IV.A. 1. Outpatient surgery. When a patient presents for outpatient surgery (same day surgery), code the reason for the surgery as the first-listed diagnosis (reason for the encounter), even if the surgery is not performed due to a contraindication.

ASC Coding and Billing: Know What's Important - AAPC ...

One of the most common coding mistakes is coding based on a procedure's headings instead of the actual surgical report. Many ambulatory surgical centers and other freestanding outpatient facilities wisely wait for the complete surgeon's report rather than bill immediately for what were scheduled services, as sometimes fewer (or different) procedures are actually noted in the final report.
