The Supplement incorporates results of a detailed search of the National Library of Canada's online union catalogue, AMICUS. It reflects a re-examination of sources checked earlier in order to retrieve works indexed too late for inclusion in the first edition. An errata sheet for the small number of errors uncovered in the main volume is also attached. The user should note that the combined contents of the first edition main volume, this Supplement, and the errata sheet in the Supplement

are equivalent to the contents of the revised and expanded edition of *Gay Canada*, published by this press in 2002.
