Carolina. The data in this study was collected from one school in a rural county in eastern North Carolina. Five teachers were chosen from three separate academic departments and a mixed methods approach was used to gather data from a state standardized End of Course assessment in Biology, North Carolina Final Exam in American History II and Civics, and a state Career Technical assessment in Animal Science I.
