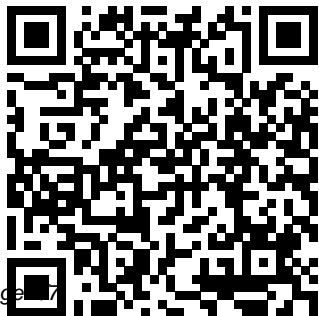

If an individual becomes certified in all three disciplines they become an American Mountain Guide/IFMGA Guide. For each discipline (Alpine, Rock, and Ski) there is a series of courses and a final exam totaling between 26 and 42 days (86 days to terminal certification)

of rigorous instruction and examination with experienced IFMGA/American Mountain Guide teachers and mentors.
