There is minimal research examining the inter-rater reliability of Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) instructors in evaluating CPR skills. This study determined the inter-rater reliability among American Red Cross CPR for the Professional Rescuer instructors in evaluating the successful completion of the

components of CPR through video review. There were two groups, one who utilized a component checklist and the other who had the checklist and a component remediation sheet. It was hypothesized that there would be a significant difference between the two groups, with the remediation group performing better in regards to identifying correct/incorrect components of CPR. Participants (n=17) completed the video evaluation. Inter-rater reliability was high (.85),

among the instructors as determined by interobserver agreement. An independent sample t-test revealed there was no significant difference (p=.943) between the two groups. The hypothesis was not supported in this research. Future research should be completed across the nation with a larger sample size; this would possibly yield different results.
