The digestive system is divided into two major parts: The digestive tract (alimentary canal) is a continuous tube with two openings: the mouth and the anus. It includes the mouth, pharynx, esophagus, stomach, small intestine, and large intestine. Food passing through the internal cavity, or lumen, of the digestive tract does not technically enter the body until it is absorbed through the walls of the digestive tract and passes into blood or lymphatic vessels.

NonInflammatory Digestive Disorders: Cirrhosis- of the liver is characterized by scarring, which results from connective tissue replacing destroyed liver cells. It may be caused by hepatitis, alcoholism's, nutritional deficiencies or live parasites.

The Stomach - Anatomy and Physiology

As the food travels along the digestive tract, various enzymes are released, which chemically change the complex polymers into the basic monomers that our bodies will ultimately use. Secretion.
