Open-ended question definition: An open-ended question (also known as Comment or Verbatim) cannot be answered with a simple "yes", "no", or one-word answer. This question type leaves a space for respondents to enter their own comments and thoughts.

An open-ended question is a question that cannot be answered with a "yes" or "no" response, or with a static response. Open-ended questions are phrased as a statement which requires a response. The response can be compared to information that is already known to the questioner.  
**Best Answers for Open-Ended Job Interview Questions**  
Open-ended questions are questions that allow someone to give a free-form answer. Closed-ended questions can be answered with “ Yes ” or “ No, ” or they have a limited set of possible answers (such as: A, B, C, or All of the Above).

The respondent can answer whatever seems best to him/her this provides greater freedom to the respondents and in-depth data can be collected using open-ended questions both in interviews as well as in questionnaires.

Open-ended questions are a type of unstructured survey question that allows the respondent more room to reply in an open text format thereby providing the opportunity to give more detailed answers. The only limitation usually imposed is a character limit so open-ended questions can be divided into long answer and short answer questions.

2. Where exactly did you first hear about us? An open “ How did you find out about us? ” question leaves users to ...

Once again, Comprehension Open-Ended is testing a student ’ s ability to understand the passage and the questions. Giving specific answers shows that the student is able to both understand the passage and answer confidently. One the other hand, giving vague answers is problematic as the required information is sorely lacking.
