OPEN-ENDED RESPONSES

Open-ended questions are defined as free-form survey questions that allows a respondent to answer in open text format such that they can answer based on their complete knowledge, feeling, and understanding. This means that response to this question is not limited to a set of options.

An open-ended question is a question that requires a full answer, using the subject's own knowledge or feelings. These questions are objective, do not lead the person being asked, and result in an answer that requires an explanation. Examples of open-ended questions include: "What happened after I left?"

Open-ended questions ask people to provide answers in their own words and are designed to elicit more information than is possible in a multiple choice or other closed-ended format. Writing a good open-ended question is a tricky balancing act: It should elicit the respondents to answer with useful information, but also give them the freedom to respond as they choose.

These tasks, open-ended questions as well as research simulations (often described as performance assessments), require students to construct their own responses rather than select them from a set of given possibilities.

Open-ended questions cannot be answered with a simple " yes " or " no. " Instead, they have multiple potential right answers, and require thought, reflection, and explanation from the person responding. That being said, open-ended questions require as much effort to write as they do to answer.

Open-ended questions are questions that allow someone to give a free-form answer. Closed-ended questions can be answered with “ Yes ” or “ No, ” or they have a limited set of possible answers (such as: A, B, C, or All of the Above).
