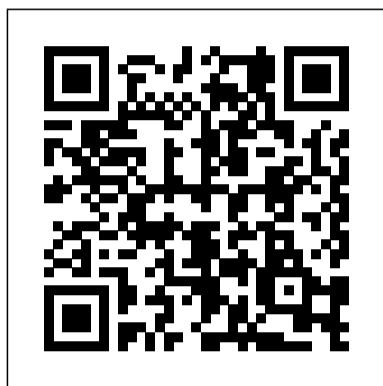

Purpose: The purpose of the study was to examine the relationship between participation in a simulated neonatal resuscitation on neonatal intensive care unit (NICU) nurses' knowledge of the Neonatal Resuscitation Program (NRP) guidelines and accuracy of the psychomotor skills required during resuscitation. Design: An educational project design was used. Method: NICU nurses employed at a regional hospital in Central Illinois were asked to complete a short, online survey, participate in a simulated resuscitation, and then complete the same online survey as before. Answers from before and after the simulation were compared and evaluated for knowledge of NRP. Resuscitation skill performance was assessed during the hands-on session. (N = 10). Findings: Prior to participation in the simulated neonatal resuscitation, 90% of NICU nurses did not have complete knowledge of NRP guidelines (N=9). During the simulated resuscitation, one out of ten NICU nurses required correction on providing ventilation per NRP guidelines. After the hands-on portion of this project, only one of the then NICU nurses did not answer all NRP based questions correctly (N=1). Conclusions: Participation in simulated neonatal resuscitation improves NICU nurses' knowledge of NRP and provides a safe place to practice and improve on resuscitation skills. Participation in simulated resuscitations should be implemented more frequently on nursing units to improve life-saving skills.
