Creator's last name, first initial. (Role of creator). (Year of creation). Title of image or description of image. [Type of work].

Retrieved from URL/database. Note: If you can only find the screen name of an author (such as a photographer on Flickr), that will do as the author's name. If the screen name is all lowercase, keep the name lowercase in the in-text citation and the references list.

Note: All citations should be double spaced and have a hanging indent in a Reference List.

A "hanging indent" means that each subsequent line after the first line of your citation should be indented by 0.5 inches.

Using references in text. For APA, you use the authors' surnames only and the year of publication in text. If you are using a direct quote, you will also need to use a page number. If you are using the authors' names as part of the sentence, normal sentence rules apply - always use "and", and never us an "&".

Include any edition information in parentheses after the title, without italics. If the book includes a DOI, include the DOI in the reference after the publisher name. Do not include the publisher location. If the book does not have a DOI and is an ebook from an academic research database, end the book reference after the publisher name.

Your reference list should be ordered alphabetically by author and then chronologically by year of publication. The APA 6th style requires the references to be indented as illustrated below in the examples. For instances of multiple articles with the same authors and years of publication, please check the APA publication manual or Academic Writer. If you have the DOI for the journal article, you should include it in the reference, otherwise, it is not nec essary.

Reference Examples - APA Style 6th edition- Citing Sources ...

The APA 6th Style manual specifies the following for the reference list. The word References should appear in bold in upper and lower case and be centred at the top of the page. All reference entries should be double-spaced. All references should be in a "hanging indent" format. (This means that the first line of each reference is flush against the left margin and the subsequent lines of each reference are indented).
