What is the APA Citation Style? The APA citation style is a parenthetical author-date style, meaning that you need to put the author's last name and the publishing date into parentheses wherever another source is used in the narrative. The APA format consists of in-text citations and a reference list, along with guidelines for formatting the paper itself.

APA Chapter or Authored Section of an Edited Book Citation.

Examples are not double-spaced, but your References list should be double-spaced; Examples do not show indented lines after the first line, but yours should be indented

When referring to a chapter in an authored book, usually you would not cite that chapter in the reference list. Instead, you would cite the whole book and, if necessary, cite the chapter in text. This rule applies whether the chapter is written by one of the book's primary authors or by a separate contributor.
