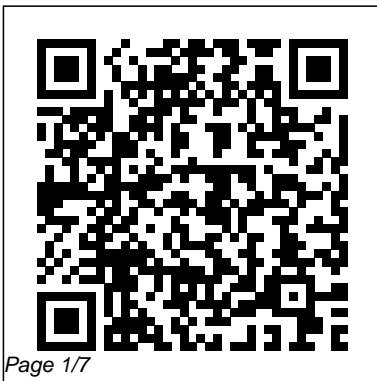

When should I include the edition in an APA book citation?

The 6th edition of the APA manual requires you to include the publisher's location when you cite from a print book. The city and state should be included for US-based publishers, the city and country for publishers anywhere else. If you are following the 7th edition, just write the name of the publisher - no location information is required.

Answer Your reference list should include the edition of the book that you read and are relying on for your information. You need to include references to more than one edition only if you read two or more editions of the same book and are using information from each one in your paper.

If the book or chapter you are citing lists a DOI, include it at the end of your

reference in place of the publisher information, without a period. Cite the edition of the book you used. If there aren't multiple editions of the book, or if it isn't a multivolume work, then do not include this information in your reference.

Numbers in parentheses refer to specific pages in the APA 6th Edition manual. APA Citation Style does not have a separate category for government publications. According to APA, government documents can be considered
