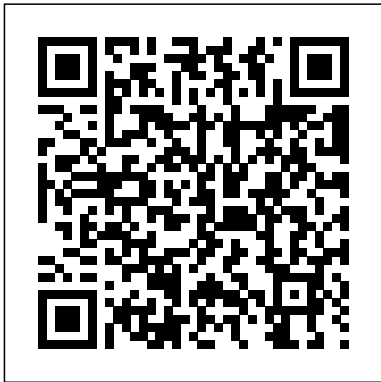

Shorten publisher's name to most concise form. End the citation with a period. NOTE: For more information about book citations, see pages 202-203 of the APA Manual, 6th ed. For title format or publication information, see pages 185 & 186 respectively in the APA Manual, 6th ed.

When citing an entire edited book in APA format, place

the names of editors in the author position and follow it with Ed. or Eds. in parentheses. See below for examples of citing edited books in their entirety and also APA citation format for chapters in edited books.

Numbers in parentheses refer to specific pages in the APA 6th Edition manual. APA Citation Style does not have a separate category for government publications.

Apa Book Citation Edition

If the book or chapter you are citing lists a DOI, include it at the end of your reference in place of the publisher information, without a period. Cite the edition of the book you used. If there aren't multiple editions of the book, or if it isn't a multivolume work, then do not include this information in your reference.

Reference List: Books // Purdue Writing Lab

The 6th edition of the APA manual requires you to include the publisher's location when you cite from a print book. The city and state should be included for US-based publishers, the city and country for publishers anywhere else. If you are following the 7th edition, just write the name of the publisher – no location information is required.
