A general author – date format is utilized for in-text citations, with full publication details included in an alphabetically ordered reference list at the end of your paper. Referencing edited books, such as collected volumes of essays, differs from referencing other printed books when using APA style citations.

While APA requires italics for the title of a book, the title of a chapter in a book goes in regular type. Provide the information for the book's editor and the book after the chapter title: Author's last name, first Initial(s).

Chapter from an Edited Volume More commonly, you'll need to cite a single essay or chapter from an edited volume. In this case, you should give the chapter author's surname and the year of publication for the edited volume in citations.

Chapter in an edited book - print version. Author(s) of chapter – family name and initials, use & for multiple authors. (Year of publication). Title of chapter. In Editor(s) – initial(s) and family name - of book (Ed. OR Eds.), Title of book – italicised (pp).

For a chapter or article in an edited print book, include the word 'In' before the name of the editor/s as shown in the reference list example. Note that the editor's initials are placed before the surname. In-text, cite the chapter or article author(s) and the year of publication.

Citing a chapter in the APA format is the trickiest part, because edited books are a collection of different chapters from different authors and different books. AUTHOR(S) OF CHAPTER For chapters of edited books, put each author's last name, then a comma, then the first initial of the first name, then any additional initials. A period should follow each initial. Separate the last author from the second-to-last author with a comma and ampersand (&).

If you want to cite a book chapter in APA format, you need to include the chapter author's name either in the introductory phrase before the quote or in the parenthetical citation after it, along with the publication date and page number. For the Reference page, make sure you include the author, chapter title, editor, book title, page range, and publication information.

Edited, Translated & Other Books - Reference in APA 6th ...

If the book or chapter you are citing lists a DOI, include it at the end of your reference in place of the publisher information, without a period. Cite the edition of the book you used. If there aren't multiple editions of the book, or if it isn't a multivolume work, then do not include this information in your reference.
