To create a reference for a chapter in an authored book, just create a reference for the entire book. Follow the authored print book example as a guide for creating the reference in the reference list. Do not include any chapter information within the reference.

Basic book citation format. The APA in-text citation for a book includes the author ’ s last name, the year, published, the full title of the source, and the URL or page range.  
and (if relevant) a page number. In the reference list, start with the author ’ s last name and initials, followed by the year. The book title is written in sentence case (only capitalize the first word and any proper nouns).

An APA in-text citation includes only three items: the last name (s) of the author (s), the year the source was published, and sometimes the page or location of the information. References include more information such as the name of the author (s), the year the source was published, the full title of the source, and the URL or page range.
