Are Zebra Mussels Really Invading Answers
Most of the biological impacts of zebra mussels in North America are not yet known.

However, information from Europe tells us that zebra mussels have the potential to severely impact native mussels (also known as clams) by interfering with their feeding, growth, locomotion, respiration, and reproduction.
