In other words, they

would receive a "seal of approval" from the state of Arizona once they establish residency in the state, without having to take an Arizona licensing exam or logging the prescribed hours of training. The bill does allow the state to decline this right of reciprocity for a disqualifying criminal history.

Reciprocity/Comity in Different States - Engineer Boards
No. In order to qualify for

registration as a Structural Engineer in the state of Arizona, an applicant must first pass the NCEES 16-hour Structural Engineering examination or have a current registration in Arizona as an Engineer AND meet the requirements of A.R.S. §32.126(B)(1).

The Arizona Board of Technical Registration is a self-sustaining regulatory board

consisting of nine members, appointed by the Governor, who represent the professional fields regulated by the Board.

An engineer is eligible for reciprocity if they hold a license or registration from a state or territory of the U.S. the requirements and qualifications for

If an applicant is granted reciprocity, the CSLB may waive the trade portion of the exam, but retains the right to require the exam. The applicant will still be required to take the business law portion of CSLB's exam. For more information on

Please note that the Texas Board of Professional Engineers does not currently have reciprocity with any other U.S. state. Licensees in Texas that wish to be licensed in another state must apply to each state board according to that

Arizona professional engineer licenses are renewed every three years from the original date of licensure. Board Website: Arizona State Board of Technical Registration. Arkansas Professional

Engineers. Arkansas Professional Engineers are required to complete 15 PDH every year by December 31 st. Arizona Professional Engineer Reciprocity Pursuant to A.R.S. § 32-4404(C), a person may obtain additional public records related to any licensee or certificate holder, including dismissed complaints and non-disciplinary actions and orders, by

contacting the Board at 602-364-4930. Engineer License Requirements (50 State Guide) | Harbor ... Arizona currently requires Structural Engineering applicants to complete the 16-hour NCEES SE Exam and have 3 or 4 years of qualified experience after completing an approved Master's

or Bachelor's degree program, respectively, in order to receive professional registration. There are also provisions for licensure through comity with other states.
