Pursuant to A.R.S. § 32-4404(C), a person may obtain additional public records related to any licensee or certificate holder, including dismissed complaints and non-disciplinary actions and orders, by contacting the Board at 602-364-4930.

Arizona Professional Engineer License Renewal Requirements

Structural Licensure. Arizona currently requires Structural Engineering applicants to complete the 16-hour NCEES SE Exam and have 3 or 4 years of qualified experience after completing an approved Master's or Bachelor's degree program, respectively, in order to receive professional registration. There are also provisions for licensure through comity with other states.

Arizona Society of Professional Engineers

Alabama Professional Engineers Alabama professional engineers are required to complete 15 PDH each year by December 31st.

To become licensed, engineers

must complete a four-year college degree, work under a Professional Engineer for at least four years, pass two intensive competency exams and earn a license from their state's licensure board. Then, to retain their licenses, PEs must continually maintain and improve their skills throughout their careers.

An engineer is eligible for reciprocity if they hold a license or registration from a state or territory of the

U.S. the requirements and qualifications for which are “reasonably equivalent” to the Professional Engineer’s Registration Act.

Reciprocity may also be granted with a certificate from NCEES.

Successful completion of a written Principles and Practice in Engineering (PE) examination, testing an applicant's knowledge and skills in a specific engineering discipline and engineering ethics. A requisite amount of engineering experience, which for most states is four years and is usually under the supervision of a professional engineer.
