### **U.S.ARMY RANK AND INSIGNIA IDENTIFICATION WW1**

The service stripes are worn centered on the outside bottom half of the left sleeve on the Army green uniform coat.

---

The service stripe is placed at an angle of 45 degrees with the lower end toward the inside seam of the sleeve, and it is placed 4 inches from the bottom of the sleeve.
