It is also known as Low-Level Laser Therapy (LLLT) and Cold Laser.

However, PBM is the most commonly used terminology and is an emerging medical technique in which exposure to low-level laser light or light emitting diodes stimulate cellular function leading to beneficial clinical effects.

Complementary, Alternative, or Integrative Health: What's ...

Unlike ethnopharmacology, Ayurveda is the “science of life” (Ayusho veda) and hence differs

principally and fundamentally from modern medicine. Ayurveda defines health as “the equilibrium of the three biological humors or the doshas (Vata, pitta and kapha), seven dhatus , agni and a state of pleasure or happiness of the soul, senses and the mind”.
