Bacteria gram stain are based on physical and chemical properties of the cell wall. The cell wall is composed of P eptidoglycan, which is a layer of the cell wall made of sugar and amino acids. If bacteria absorbs the stain and turns purple it is gram-positive bacteria. If bacteria does not absorb

the stain and turns pink is gram-negative bacteria.
