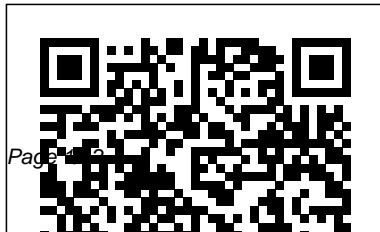

Indeed, as the games began, a US News and World Report magazine questioned whether the Lake Placid games were the "last Olympics." Winter Games were a long shot, if not a miracle too. Winning the games had been an unlikely decades-long quest for this small town to overcome the barriers of exploding finances, environmental concerns and world politics.
