Aim: The aim of this randomized, controlled, clinical and parallel study was to compare the effect of manual and powered toothbrushes for biofilm control in patients with implant supported fixed restorations. Material&Methods: A total of 20 patients, aged between 35-60, with 42 implants with bleeding on probing, no residual pocket depth (≥ 265 5 mm), and no radiographic peri-implant bone loss were included. All patients were in a regular recall schedule. Patients were instructed to brush with a manual (Oral-B Indicator 35 Soft) or a powered tooth brush (Oral-B Braun Genius) with a soft bristle head 2 times a day for 2 minutes. The following periodontal parameters such as presence/absence of ulceration/desquamation of gingival alveolar mucosa surrounding the abutments (visual inspection), modified plaque index (mPI) (Mombelli et al. 1987), bleeding on probing, modified gingival index (mGI) (Mombelli et al. 1987), probing pocket depth, and attached peri-implant tissue index was measured at baseline and 3 months. For each variable, patient served as a statistical unit. For all parameters, intra-group and inter-group analysis was performed with Wilcoxon Signed Ranku2019s and Mann Whitney U test, respectively.
