Medical residents in hospitals are often required to be on duty for long hours. In 2003 the organization overseeing graduate medical education

adopted common program requirements to restrict resident workweeks, including limits to an average of 80 hours over 4 weeks and the longest consecutive period of work to 30 hours in order to protect patients and residents from unsafe conditions resulting from excessive fatigue.

At elevated temperature, hydrothermal features, hydrothermal ore deposits and geothermal fields are associated with chemical effects of water-rock interaction.
