were utilized by Special Day Class (SDC) teachers to prepare their 9-12 grade students to pass a course in Algebra 1 and the mathematics section of the California High School Exit Exam (CAHSEE). The research methodology was a mixed-methods design. The quantitative aspect of the study consisted of items on a questionnaire administered to the SDC teacher population in two unified school districts in a Northern California county. The qualitative data for this research consisted of two open-ended questions from the questionnaire, interviews with three successful SDC teachers, an observation of each teacher, a follow-up interview with each teacher, and document analysis. In summation, the majority of respondents to the questionnaire stated they used direct instruction as the primary teaching strategy to help SDC students pass a course of Algebra 1. The qualitative data showed that all three focus teachers used a step-by-step method to teach their students how to identify and solve different types of linear equations. Beginning in the 2008/09 school year, California's State Board of Education recommended that students complete algebra I by the end of grade 8. Between 2003 and 2009 the proportion of grade 8 students taking algebra I rose from 32 percent to 54

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percent (Williams et al., 2011). This increase resulted in a larger percentage of grade 8 students scoring "proficient" or "advanced" (achieving proficiency) on the algebra I California Standards Test (CST; see box 1 for definitions of key terms used in this report) and in a larger number of grade 8 students scoring "far below basic" or "below basic" on the test (Williams et

al., 2011). Recent studies show that enrolling in algebra I in grade 8 works well for some students but backfires for others. The consequences of misplacement are most pronounced for students with weaknesses in key foundational areas that support algebra readiness, which frequently translates into difficulty reaching proficiency in higher level math in high school (Finkelstein et
