The name velvet spider describes the dark and shiny appearance of members of the family Eresidae. Some species also have brightly-colored highlights, such as the red, white, and black ladybird spiders of Europe and North Asia. This family also includes some of the world's most cooperative spider species. Social species can be very abundant in parts of tropical Africa and Asia with conspicuous colonies dotting the landscape. Social colonies may consist of

hundreds of closely-related individuals that participate in dramatic mass attacks on prey and care for their young. Remaining sections address: principles of revision and guides for future revision; liturgical propers for seasons (Advent/Christmas,

Lent, and Easter); and new
propers for a miscellany of
propers usable with
individuals (or events) not
officially listed in the
formal calendar. Two cycles
of propers for daily
Eucharist are also included,
one covering a six week
period, the other a two year
cycle.
