Orthodox theologian Jean-Yves Leloup ’ s translation from the Coptic and his analysis of this gospel are presented here for the first time in English. What emerges from this important source text is a restoration of the

sacred initiatic union between the male and female principles that was once at the heart of Christianity ' s sacred mystery.
