Chapter 2.2 – Flow of Energy in an Ecosystem

The flow chamber, and hence the flow stream, is charged ($\pm v$ where v typically lies between 50 and 150 V) at the moment a cell of interest is inside the droplet currently being formed. The stream of droplets passes through a pair of charged plates (± 5000 V) so that the charged droplets are deflected and collected together with the cell contained therein (Figure 2.16).
