Movements or lane groups with volume-to-capacity ratios less than 0.85 are considered undersaturated and typically have sufficient capacity and stable operations.

The capacity can change for a given volume, e.g. if you double the number of seats in an airplane, its capacity doubles, whereas the volume remains constant.
