loss. Periodontitis is also associated with systemic alterations like low-grade inflammation, dyslipidemia, glucose intolerance, endothelial dysfunction. The term metabolic syndrome (MetS) which was first coined by Haller and Hanefeld in 1975 , is characterized as a combination of underlying risk factors that when occurring together, culminate in adverse outcomes, including type 2 diabetes mellitus (T2DM), cardiovascular disease (CVD) and thus an approximately 1.6-fold increase in mortality. The major risk factors for developing MetS are physical inactivity and a diet high in fats and carbohydrates. These are often related to the individual's life style (overweight, sedentary habits), or existing pathological conditions (e.g. obesity and hypercholesterolemia)(Lakka et al. 2002)
