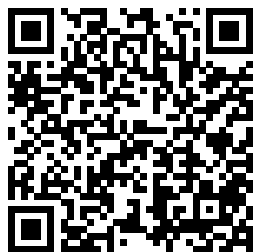

I also exercise a certain degree of care when discussing them. For obvious reasons, I intentionally avoid reporting on the manners by which

they can be produced. As in earlier editions of this book, I continue to emphasize the hazardous materials regulations promulgated by the Occupational Safety and Health Administration, the U.S. Department of Transportation, and the Environmental Protection Agency. In this edition, I have updated the regulations to reflect changes that have occurred since publication of the third edition. I have worked to make this fourth edition more comprehensive and easier for nonscientists to learn and understand. To do so, I crafted

performance goals so students are apprised up front of what they should learn in each section. I have also listed the names of chemical substances undereachformula in every equation so students can more readily comprehend the relevant chemical change. I also constructed new Solved Exercises and Review Exercises, and I expanded the glossary to include the definitions of new technical terms and phrases in use by emergency responders.
