The Nocturnes Op 9 are a set of three nocturnes written by Fr é d é ric Chopin. Chopin wrote this particular nocturne at the age of 20! Nocturne Opus 9, No. 2 has a time signature of 12/8 meaning that there are 12 quaver beats per bar. The nocturne opens with a legato melody. Chopin 's Nocturne Opus 9, No.2's song structure is a rounded binary form with coda. In music, the binary form consists of two sections, A and B. Section A is often played with variation and is normally rounded off ...

Chopin composed his best-known Nocturne in E-flat major, Op. 9, No. 2 when he was around twenty years old. This well-known nocturne is in rounded binary form (A, A, B, A, B, A) with coda, C. It is 34 measures long and written in 12/8 meter, having a similar structure to a waltz.

Chopin's Nocturne in C sharp minor is a short piece – about 3.5 minutes long. By today's pop music standards that would be considered normal, but it was short against the backdrop of Classical music. This particular nocturne was written in 1830 but wasn't published until 1870, 26 years after Chopin's death.

The first dozen bars or so of the Nocturne in F minor, which together with the Nocturne in E flat major comprises opus 55, were written into the album of Elizabeth Sheremetev. The opening theme, which is also the principal theme of this work, returns often, slightly altered nearly every time. It bears a melancholy that is deepened by the almost obsessive repetition of the initial melody, which proceeds in a tempo and rhythm characteristic of nocturne contemplation.

Tonal, Structural, and Narrative Analysis

Chopin wrote the Nocturne in C# Minor in 1830 — dedicating it to his older sister, Ludwika Chopin, with the statement: " To my sister Ludwika as an exercise before beginning the study of my second Concerto".

The Nocturne typically constitutes a romantic, dreamy character suggestive of the night. The main feature of most Nocturnes is a beautiful song-like melody, often with melancholic overtones accompanied by a rolling unobtrusive bass. Ornament passages and filigree in the melody are commonplace, and the importance of the sustaining pedal cannot be overestimated bestowing the overall dramatic effect.

Chopin's sixth nocturne begins with a slow lento tempo and is written in 3/4 time. The right hand part is composed of simple eighth and quarter note patterns, followed by a chromatic rise and fall. The left hand part maintains quarter note patterns to support the right hand, with pedal marks every six notes.

The Nocturne in E flat major, though certainly not the most beautiful of Chopin 's nocturnes, is perhaps the most popular, particularly among young would be pianists. Jan Kleczy ski supposes that 'this charming bagatelle did more for the popularity of Chopin than all his other works'.
