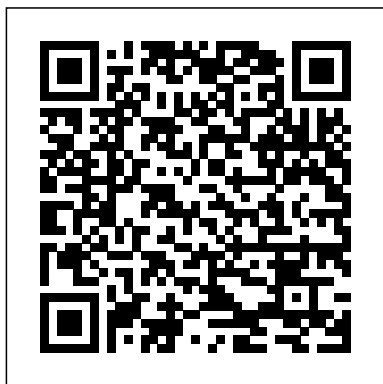

Color Mixing Guide Starting Base: White, Black, Orange, Yellow, Brown. Percentages will be determined by color to which you are matching. Not all colors may be needed. Darken: Black, Brown Black kills “brightness” of Yellow/Orange tone while darkening. Brown darkens while retaining Orange tone. Lighten: White lightens, does not change tone.
