Configuration management is a systems development discipline that promotes the proper identification of the configuration, control of changes, and records the change implementation status of the physical and functional characteristics of the Interim C2C system. Configuration Management identifies what is required, designed, and produced.

The maintenance control system must include procedures to ensure that an aeroplane is not dispatched for an ETOPS flight following maintenance actions that affect multiple similar elements in any system determined to be an ETOPS significant system (e.g. fuel control change on both engines) and ensure that:
