Moderate sedation/analgesia can be used to achieve a number of objectives. Moderate sedation allows a patient to tolerate an unpleasant procedure while maintaining consciousness and cooperation. Many of the pharmacologic agents used will provide mood alteration and partial amnesia.

•Moderate Sedation: (formerly "Conscious Sedation") –Moderate sedation is a drug-induced depression of consciousness during which patients respond purposefully to verbal commands\* either alone or accompanied by light tactile stimulation. –No interventions are required to maintain a patent airway, and spontaneous ventilation is adequate.
