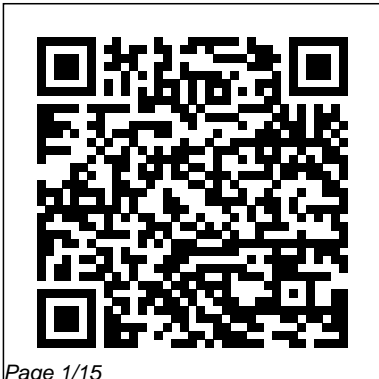

Of the two remaining categories (CD players and answering machines), a dual market was observed, yet the model did not yield a drop off in sales, but rather a clear delay in the adoption
