Purpose: To provide evidence-based guidelines for early enteral nutrition (EEN) during critical illness. Methods: We aimed to compare EEN vs. early parenteral nutrition (PN) and vs. delayed EN. We defined "early" EN as EN started within 48 h independent of type or amount. We listed, a priori, conditions in which EN is often delayed, and performed systematic reviews in 24 such subtopics.

The aim of these protocols is to empower nurses to increase feeding rates to make up for volume lost while EN is held.
