With her mom ’ s mental condition greatly improving, her mom ’ s physical condition began to deteriorate rapidly. The number of doctors for her care grew to nine. Exhaustion and insomnia took over Madelyn ’ s life, but she kept going due to her love for her mother and the kindness of her mom under terrible circumstances. It was a roller-coaster life, growing up in a dysfunctional family which never included alcohol, drug abuse, or physical or mental abuse.
