The first question facing the delegates was whether to attempt to amend the Articles of Confederation or to throw out the Articles and create a new framework of government. The decision was made early on to create a new framework embodied in a new national constitution. At this point, the convention became known as the Constitutional Convention.

The Court moved closer to the Johnson decision in 1974, when it held in *Spence v. Washington* that a person couldn't
