When he gained his freedom, he wrote his famous memoir and spent some years lecturing across the US, on behalf of the abolitionist movement. 'Twelve Years a Slave' was published a year after 'Uncle Tom's

Cabin' by Harriet Beecher Stowe and built on the antislavery momentum it had developed. Northup's final years are something of a mystery, though it is thought that he struggled to cope with family life after few Americans being freed.
