Identity issues have become very delicate especially with the increase in security challenges. For instance, if you are going through airport security, you are made to take everything out of your bag, remove your belts, jackets and even take your shoes off. At the time of boarding the aircraft, additional information is asked for- any personal identification document, like international passport or national identity card. In spite of the fact that you have a valid boarding pass, without proper identification you cannot go into the aircraft. All these processes can be really annoying but are necessary for proper investigation and security. In the same vein, what do you own as an individual that reveals your personal information? A birth certificate, a certificate of origin? What are you carrying with you right now that contains your personal information? An identity card, a driver's license, a credit/debit card, a checkbook, any piece of paper containing your phone number or birthday, your phone itself? All these tell a lot about you, who you are, where you come from. It is therefore very important to keep all these information about yourself secure and be careful to whom you reveal what about yourself, to prevent any form of identity misplacement and even to protect your physical identity from being stolen. Tied very closely to identity is the concept of self-worth, which refers to the value or the price tag one places on one's self. Your identity announces your worth. The higher the quality of your identity the higher your worth! Knowing your true identity is the key to knowing the enormity of your capacity for good or evil. It is the most important power that determines the quality of your thoughts and unique characteristics- why I talk and don't mew, why a dog barks and a horse neighs.
