In breast cancer, the downstaging induced by primary chemotherapy is acknowledged by all and the conviction that Jacquillat defended so heartily that breast preservation should be proposed to all patients with breast cancer whatever their tumour size is shared now by more and more people. A special emphasis was given to new drugs, new combination, new access (locoregional therapy) and new developments such as that of growth factors and of interleukin 2.
