More than one million copies were sold, generating around 4,000 in royalties, which would today put Ward in the millionaire author bracket. Her earning would have been higher if it weren't for the absence of international copyright laws when

Robert Elsmere was first published. Many cheap US editions were hurriedly produced to cash in on its success.
