Hospice Coverage

- Clinical documentation requirement for hospice coverage:
 - Patient record must support documentation in technical elements.
- Terminal prognosis of 6 months or less
- LCD criteria – Days in any billing period without corresponding documentation showing eligibility are unpaid. IDG, CARE PLAN, SERVICE COORDINATION

In hospice, we need to document achievement of goals while also

documenting the progress of a patient's disease which in most cases is declining. When patients are having good days, I think it is sometimes natural to focus on that in documentation and not always accurately document the physical things that are still going on. ”
